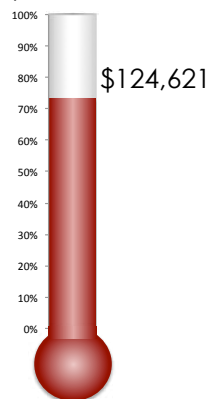

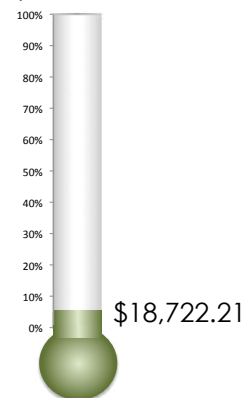
Our Sanctuary Roof
