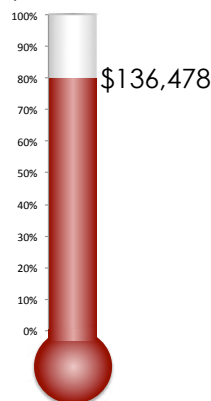

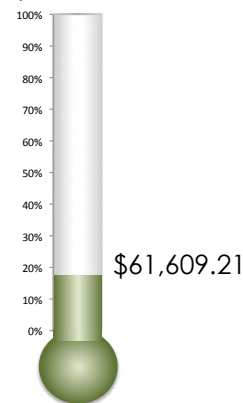
## Our Sanctuary Roof
