## REFLECTING CHRIST

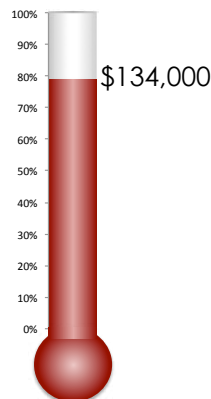

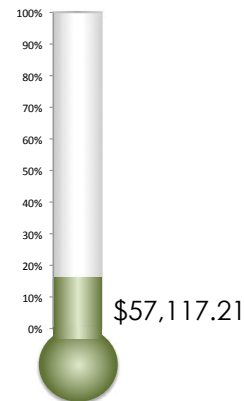
## Our Sanctuary Roof
