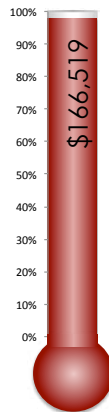

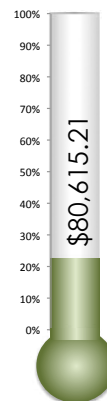
## Our Sanctuary Roof

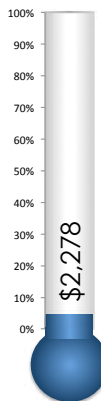
## Outdoor School Property
