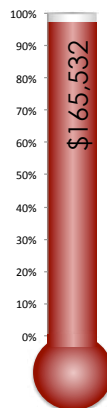

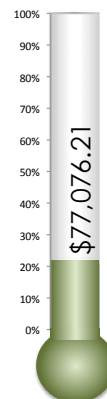
## Our Sanctuary Roof

\$170,000



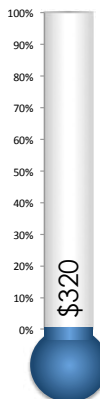
## Outdoor School Property
