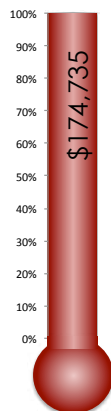

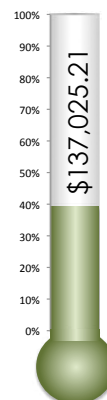

Outdoor School Property

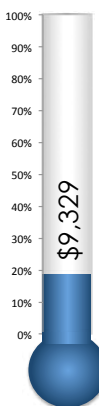
