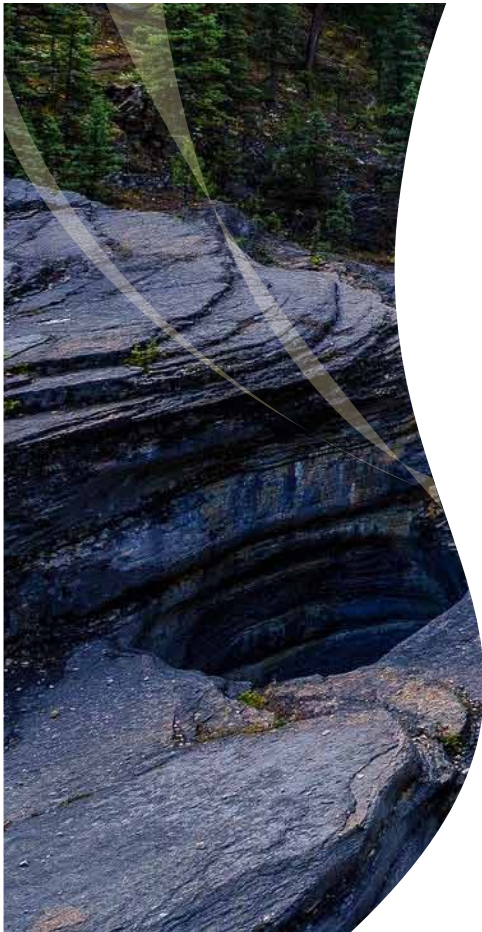

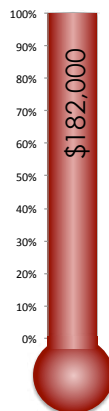

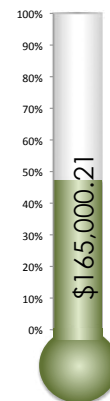

2021 Year End Figures

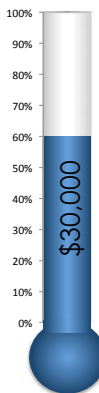
Outdoor School Property
