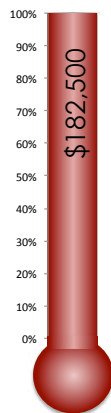

Our Sanctuary Roof

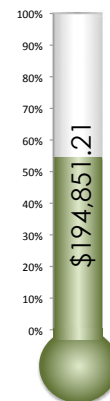

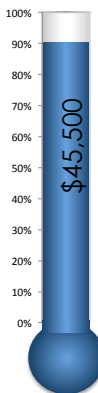
Outdoor School Property
