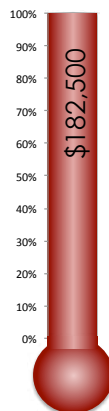

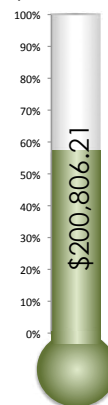

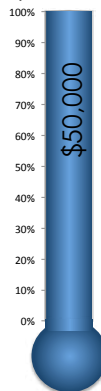
Outdoor School Property
